## Project Description

According to the bank website, the project consists of a loan of up to EUR 20.3 million (or RON equivalent) to the City of Timisoara to support the City's priority public transport infrastructure alongside EU co-financing under the relevant EU Regional Operational Programme 2014-2020. The loan will support: (i) the renewal of the City's tram fleet,(ii) the rehabilitation of the tram line, (iii) the update of the City's sustainable urban mobility plan, (iv) the improvement of public transport services in Timisoara, and (v) the preparation of a Green City Action Plan.
