The provision of a senior secured loan of up to US\$ 20 million to Nika Pharm for financing (i) the upgrade of equipment to increase capacity, (ii) the launch of GMP standard for medicines manufacturing requirements, and (iii) balance sheet restructuring through debt consolidation.

PROJECT OBJECTIVES

The project aims to boost competitiveness and promote human capital development. It will allow expanding pharmaceuticals production to meet growing local demand. Nika Pharm will launch new training programmes tailored to its needs, focusing on roles scarce in the local labour market.

If you submit a complaint to the PCM, it may assess compliance with EBRD's own policies and procedures to prevent harm to the environment or communities or it may assist you in resolving the problem that led to the complaint through a dialogue with those implementing the project. Additionally, the PCM has the authority to recommend a project be suspended in the event that harm is imminent.
