### Project Description

According to the Bank's website, the project consists of the provision of a senior unsecured loan of up to EUR7 million (the "GFF Loan") to be provided in two tranches of: (i) EUR2 million, and (ii) EUR5 million under the Green Finance Facility in North Macedonia ("GFF").

The loan is intended to provide sub-loans to SMEs in North Macedonia to support investments in eligible RE and/or EE projects ("Sub-projects"). 100% of the use of proceeds will be related to Green Economy Transition ("GET") investments.

### Investment Description

- European Bank for Reconstruction and Development (EBRD)

A senior unsecured loan of up to €7 million (the "GFF Loan") to be provided in two tranches of: (i) €2 million, and (ii) €5 million under the Green Finance Facility in North Macedonia ("GFF").

### Financial Intermediary

Financial Intermediary: A commercial bank or financial institution that receives funds from a development bank. A financial intermediary then lends these funds to their clients (private actors) in the form of loans, bonds, guarantees and equity shares. Financial intermediaries include insurance, pension and equity funds. The direct financial relationship is between the development bank and the financial intermediary.
