Project Description

As stated by the EBRD, the project consists of a senior loan of up to EUR 62.9m to Mugla Water and Sewage Administration ("MUSKI") in Turkiye. The Project includes (i) rehabilitation of existing water transmission and distribution lines, (ii) installation of water meters, and (iii) procurement of Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition (SCADA) systems and other maintenance and monitoring equipment, subject to the outcome of technical due diligence.

The Project aims to address significant nonrevenue water (NRW) losses in Mugla's drinking water supply system, which are currently estimated at approximately 50 per cent, largely due to aging infrastructure. The shift from pumped infrastructure to gravity-based water conveyance as part of the project is expected to reduce energy use and associated GHG emissions.

By rehabilitating critical sections of the water network and introducing modern monitoring and control systems, the Project seeks to improve the reliability and efficiency of water supply services and support the longterm resilience of Mugla's urban infrastructure.
