The company is a joint venture of two Scandinavian agribusiness cooperatives - Lantmannen ek., a Swedish cooperative, and Dansk Landbrugs Grovvarereselskab a.m.b.a. (DLG), a Danish cooperative.

Lantmannen is an agricultural cooperative and a leader in agriculture, machinery, bioenergy and food products in northern Europe. The cooperative is owned by 17,000 Swedish farmers.

DLG is an agricultural cooperative and a leader in agriculture, nutrition, animal feed and energy sectors in northern Europe. The cooperative is owned by 26,000 Danish farmers.
