### Project Description

According to the Bank's website, the Project is an equity investment in (a) Proservice Finteco Sp. z o.o. ("PSF") a leading provider of investment fund administration services in Poland, and (b) Investment Funds Depositary Services S.A. ("IFDS"), a specialist provider of fund depositary services in Poland. The Bank invested alongside a consortium led by Innova Capital, a leading private equity firm based in Poland and a long-standing partner of the Bank.

Through the proposed transaction, the Bank aims to (i) bring an independent and domestic transfer agent to its next growth stage through consolidation and innovation and (ii) provide support to Innova in achieving commercial success, thus solidifying the regional PE landscape.

Additionally, the PCM has the authority to recommend a project be suspended in the event that harm is imminent.
