## Project Description

As stated by the EBRD, the transaction envisages providing a long-term secured loan of up to EUR 6.5 million to the Borrower for the construction, equipment and placing into operation of the new plant in Kazakhstan. Prosol S.r.l., a limited liability company organised in Italy, will provide full corporate guarantee for the Loan.

The proceeds of the Bank's investment will be used for the construction, equipment and placing into operation of the new feed and nutritional yeast production facility in the Qyzyljar Free Economic Zone, Kazakhstan.

- 1) The Project will have a Technical Cooperation (TC) component provided by the Japan-EBRD Cooperation Fund (JECF). The TC funds will cover 70 per cent of the legal due diligence costs (estimated total legal due diligence cost of EUR69,250). Remaining 30 per cent will be contributed by the client.
- 2) Investment grant of EUR150,000 will be allocated from the Agrifood Nexus Programme funded by the Federal Ministry for the Environment, Nature Conservation, Nuclear Safety and Consumer Protection of Germany ("BMUV").
- 3) The Project will have a Technical Cooperation (TC) component provided by the Agrifood Nexus Programme. The TC funds will cover 70 per cent of the financial due diligence costs (estimated total financial due diligence cost of EUR17,000). Remaining 30 per cent will be contributed by the client.
