## Project Description

According to the Bank's website, the project consists of the provision of up to EUR 40 million equity investment in favour of Amethis MENA Fund III S.C.A., SICAV-RAIF (the "Fund").

The Fund will seek to make equity and equity-related investments predominantly in small and medium-sized enterprises primarily in Morocco and Egypt, and selectively in Tunisia and Jordan with the objective of achieving long-term capital growth.

## Investment Description

Financial intermediaries include insurance, pension and equity funds. The direct financial relationship is between the development bank and the financial intermediary.

If you submit a complaint to the PCM, it may assess compliance with EBRD's own policies and procedures to prevent harm to the environment or communities or it may assist you in resolving the problem that led to the complaint through a dialogue with those implementing the project. Additionally, the PCM has the authority to recommend a project be suspended in the event that harm is imminent.
