Project Description

According to the Bank's website, the project consists of the provision of a senior unsecured loan of up to EUR8 million (the "GFF Loan") to be provided under the Green Finance Facility in North Macedonia ("GFF").

The loan is intended to provide sub-loans to SMEs in North Macedonia to support investments in eligible Renewable Energy (RE) and/or Energy Efficiency (EE) projects ("Sub-projects"). 100% of the use of proceeds will be related to Green Economy Transition ("GET") investments.

If you submit a complaint to the PCM, it may assess compliance with EBRD's own policies and procedures to prevent harm to the environment or communities or it may assist you in resolving the problem that led to the complaint through a dialogue with those implementing the project. Additionally, the PCM has the authority to recommend a project be suspended in the event that harm is imminent.
