Project Description

As stated by the EBRD, the project consists of the provision of a senior secured loan of up to US\$ 10.0 million to Big-Family-Farm for the expansion programme of its pharmacy chain which includes the renovation of pharmacy buildings, the procurement of equipment as well as working capital procurement.

The project aims to contribute to the improvement of pharmacy standards in the sector, given company's leading role in the adoption of Good Pharmacy Practice (GPP) standards and to increase skills supply in Uzbekistan by leveraging its existing training centre through onboarding new training programme on GPP and soft skills for sales personnel and store managers.

The company will improve the operational efficiency, enhance market penetration and improve access to pharma services in new locations including rural areas.
