Project Description

According to the Bank's website, the project consists of the provision of a senior unsecured loan of up to EUR4 million under the Western Balkans GEF III REpower Residential ("WBGEFF III", the "Framework").

The loan is intended to provide sub-loans to help finance investments in (i) high-performance energy efficiency technologies, materials and solutions undertaken in or in relation to privately owned residential dwellings or buildings, (ii) construction of GET-eligible High energy Performance Residential Buildings ("HPRBs") and (iii) eligible Energy Efficiency ("EE") and/or Renewable Energy ("RE") projects in the Public Sector ("Sub-projects"), in a gender-responsive way.



Early Warning System Project Analysis

Categorised FI (ESP 2024). Sparkasse Bank AD Skopje (SBS) is an existing client of the EBRD. The client is currently meeting the EBRD's Environmental and Social Requirements (ESRs) 2, 4, and 9 under its existing EBRD exposures. Eligible subprojects will support investments in eligible RE and EE projects of SMEs in North Macedonia, which are likely to be of low to medium environmental and social (E&S) risk. Key E&S risks include environmental and social management system (ESMS) implementation capacity, exposure to higher-risk sectors or geographies in North Macedonia, labour and H&S issues, and broader E&S impacts.

A senior unsecured loan of up to EUR4 million under the Western Balkans GEF III REpower Residential ("WBGEFF III").

Financial Intermediary

Financial Intermediary: A commercial bank or financial institution that receives funds from a development bank. Financial intermediaries include insurance, pension and equity funds. The direct financial relationship is between the development bank and the financial intermediary.

If you submit a complaint to the PCM, it may assess compliance with EBRD's own policies and procedures to prevent harm to the environment or communities or it may assist you in resolving the problem that led to the complaint through a dialogue with those implementing the project. Additionally, the PCM has the authority to recommend a project be suspended in the event that harm is imminent.
