Project Description

As stated by the EBRD, the project includes the development, construction and operation by Scatec of a 1.95 GW solar PV plant and 3.935 MWh BESS with associated grid connection. The project will be implemented in 4 locations:

- Site 1: Hybrid - Minya site: 1.95 GW solar PV and 1.5 GWh BESS located in East Minya.
- Site 2: Consumer substation: 500/220/22 kV Sub-station and 500 kV, 2.5 km Overhead Transmission line located in Al Sarirya.
- Site 3: Abu Qir: 1.435 GWh BESS, along with 33/220 kV substation located in Abo Qir, Alexandria.
- Site 4: Nagaa Hammadi: 1.0 GWh BESS along with a 33/220kV substation and Overhead Transmission Line located in Nagaa Hammadi, Qena.
