Project Description

According to EIB website, the project will finance the University's EUR 77 million investment programme 2017-2021, including a new Science Faculty building, campus extension works and energy-efficient retrofitting of the existing infrastructure. It aims to upgrade the educational and research infrastructure of the Université de Namur to strengthen its domestic and international academic standing.

The Bank's services will verify the screening decision of the competent authority during appraisal and whether an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) is required.

When dissatisfied with a complaint to the EIB Complaints Mechanism, citizens can then turn towards the European Ombudsman. A memorandum of Understanding has been signed between the EIB and the European Ombudsman establishes that citizens (even outside of the EU if the Ombudsman finds their complaint justified) can turn towards the Ombudsman on issues related to 'maladministration' by the EIB. Note that before going to the Ombudsman, an attempt must be made to resolve the case by contacting the EIB. In addition, the complaint must be made within two years of the date when the facts on which your complaint is based became known to you.
