Project Description

The project is a multi-component investment program that will be financed by the Bank and will include schemes for reinforcing, modernizing, and developing the Promoter's electricity transmission network in Italy between 2020 and 2024. The project will improve supply security by allowing additional renewable energy generation capacity to be integrated into the national transmission system. On top of traditional transmission assets, the project includes other investments to increase the network's ability to accommodate RES generation capacity, including synchronous condensers to help stabilize the network and improve operational efficiency.

ACCOUNTABILITY MECHANISM OF EIB

The EIB Complaints Mechanism is designed to facilitate and handle complaints against the EIB by individuals, organizations or corporations affected by EIB activities. When exercising the right to lodge a complaint against the EIB, any member of the public has access to a two-tier procedure, one internal - the Complaints Mechanism Office - and one external - the European Ombudsman. When dissatisfied with a complaint to the EIB Complaints Mechanism, citizens can then turn towards the European Ombudsman. A memorandum of Understanding has been signed between the EIB and the European Ombudsman establishes that citizens (even outside of the EU if the Ombudsman finds their complaint justified) can turn towards the Ombudsman on issues related to 'maladministration' by the EIB. Note that before going to the Ombudsman, an attempt must be made to resolve the case by contacting the EIB. In addition, the complaint must be made within two years of the date when the facts on which your complaint is based became known to you. You can write to the Ombudsman in any of the languages of the European Union.
