Project Description

According to the bank website, the project involves;

1. construction of I.D1 of the Prague Metro Line D from Pankrác to Nové Dvory
2. construction of a passenger connection at Pankrác between Metro Lines C and D
3. construction of a rail connection for trains from Line D to access line C
4. construction of 5 metro stations (Pankrác, Olbrachtova, Nadrazi Krc, Nemocnice Krc and Nove Dvory)
5. Procurement of 10 sets of metro trains comprising 5 cars each

ACCOUNTABILITY MECHANISM OF EIB

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When dissatisfied with a complaint to the EIB Complaints Mechanism, citizens can then turn towards the European Ombudsman. A memorandum of Understanding has been signed between the EIB and the European Ombudsman establishes that citizens (even outside of the EU if the Ombudsman finds their complaint justified) can turn towards the Ombudsman on issues related to 'maladministration' by the EIB. Note that before going to the Ombudsman, an attempt must be made to resolve the case by contacting the EIB. In addition, the complaint must be made within two years of the date when the facts on which your complaint is based became known to you.
