According to the Bank's website, the project consists in a grant facility of up to EUR 5m providing seed financing to support the construction, furnishing and validation of a fill and finish vaccine manufacturing facility in the suburbs of Accra, Ghana.

The facility will initially target vaccines that are a priority for the African continent and is expected to contribute to enhanced regional independence in health security.

ACCOUNTABILITY MECHANISM OF EIB

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When dissatisfied with a complaint to the EIB Complaints Mechanism, citizens can then turn towards the European Ombudsman. A memorandum of Understanding has been signed between the EIB and the European Ombudsman establishes that citizens (even outside of the EU if the Ombudsman finds their complaint justified) can turn towards the Ombudsman on issues related to 'maladministration' by the EIB. Note that before going to the Ombudsman, an attempt must be made to resolve the case by contacting the EIB. In addition, the complaint must be made within two years of the date when the facts on which your complaint is based became known to you. You can write to the Ombudsman in any of the languages of the European Union.
