It is an integrated forestry company founded in 2004 with operations ranging from the tree nurturing phase to the sales of finished goods (mainly transmission poles) in Uganda, Tanzania and Rwanda. The aim of this project is to quantify the amount of avoided greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions associated with FMO's investment in NFC. This will be achieved by the development of a tool and undertaking an assessment that accounts for operational GHG emissions of NFC's business, and GHG emissions and CO2 sequestration due to the growth and harvesting of plantation forests, downstream processing and sales.
