The project will consist of a mix-use complex comprised by two office towers, a retail podium, a residential tower, a Westin-managed hotel and serviced apartment building. Also located on the same site, is the 136-year old former headquarters of the British Burma Railway Company, which will be restored to preserve its cultural heritage value and house a Peninsula hotel (not part of the Project).
