It targets a new niche that has a high impact potential. It focusses on agribusinesses that work directly with small-scale fisheries, and is forecasted to advance the livelihoods of over 100,000 small-scale fishermen and the rural communities they live in. Furthermore, through its investments, the Fund aims to bring over 1.2mln ha of coastal waters under improved management.
