How to File a Complaint before the FAO's grievance mechanism

Complaints containing allegations that there has been a breach of the Organization's environmental and social standards must be made in writing and communicated to OIG by mail, courier, email or fax, directly or via any FAO office. All complaints should ideally provide, as a minimum, the following information:

- •What happened? Describe the events with as much relevant detail as possible.
- •When did it happen? Dates, time, how many times, etc.
- •Where did it happen?
- •Who do you think was involved? Who was implicated?
- •The complainant's name and contact information;
