As specific objectives, the TC aims to strengthen the Educational Information and Management System (SIGED) of the PBA, and to support the development and implementation of an IT solution for the registration and monitoring of the Program for the Promotion and Strengthening of Socio-Educational and Community Centers (CSC) in Popular Neighborhoods (BP), contributing to achieve the specific objective of AR-L1367 which is "to improve access to educational opportunities for children, adolescents and youth in contexts of vulnerability".
