This TC is designed to assist in (i) identifying and evaluating fiscal features in the Barbadian public sector that affect firms' productivity, private investment, and business environment; (ii) evaluating institutional capacity and governance to address fiscal challenges posed by external economic trends, fast demographic changes, climate change and natural disasters; and (iii) disseminating knowledge and providing training to facilitate capacity building in the MFEI.
