According to the IDB, this project will support the Sustainable Tourism Program II in its aim to mainstream disaster and climate resilience in tourism destination planning in Belize. This TC aims to develop the shoreline stabilization measures for Corozal and set precedent in further coastal studies considered by STP II including studying coastal risk baselines, designing and conducting feasibility analysis, and build capacity in coastal risk reduction and shoreline stabilization. The operation supports sustainable development in small countries and recognizes climate change's impacts on them.
