### Project Description

The project will channel loan resources to small scale clients whose main activity is agriculture and/or animal farming, integrating loans with technical assistance related to adaptation to climate change, in all of the intermediary's rural agencies in which their clients' incomes are dependent on agriculture, have highly fragmented land holdings, high levels of vulnerability and limited access to information about climate change and sustainable farming practices. It will also channel long-term loans for low-income housing.
