### Project Description

The project aims to improve economic opportunities for low-income youth in the municipalities of El Alto, La Paz and Sucre through the creation of more sustainable ventures in the hospitality sector. Specifically, this project seeks to address the limited and insufficient supply of comprehensive services required for youth entrepreneurship (“comprehensive” meaning technical training, soft skills, business training, entrepreneurial support and mentoring, and assistance to secure financing), which is not meeting the needs of young men and women in the hospitality industry. For entrepreneurial ventures with real growth potential, assistance to start and grow the business as well as mentoring will be more intensive and personalised.
