According to the IADB, the Technical Cooperation (TC) aims to support the country in strengthening institutional capacity for integrated management of climate and disaster risks. The specific objectives are: (i) to strengthen the SISRADE and the institutional capacity of the MPD to coordinate and promote corrective and prospective disaster management actions; and (ii) to enhance the institutional capacity of the MEFP to improve financial management of the country's contingent liabilities related to disasters and climate risks. Additionally, this TC will provide technical support for the implementation of the PGIRDN of the Contingent Loan BO-00010.
