Project Description

According to the IADB, the TC aims to contribute to the sustainability of investments made with loan proceeds in the water, sanitation, and solid waste management subsectors in Bolivia, by strengthening the institutions of sector entities and service operators, from the closing stage through the post-investment phase and into operation and maintenance. The specific aims are: (i) to develop tools, studies, plans, and guidelines that strengthen the management of system operation and maintenance; and (ii) to implement technical assistance and training activities aimed at strengthening operators' capacities and modernizing sector governance. Thus, the expected outcome is the consolidation of investment sustainability through improvements in the management, operation, and maintenance of services. In qualitative terms, the project aims to strengthen institutional coordination and promote more efficient, resilient, and sustainable services in the long term.
