Project Description

According to the IADB, the main objective of this Technical Cooperation (TC) is to support the strengthening of policies aimed at promoting gender and racial equality in Brazil, in a context of structural inequalities that disproportionately affect women and the Afro-descendant (AD) population, including quilombola communities, traditional communities, Afro-Brazilian religious groups ("terreiros"), and Roma people. Specifically, the TC will provide technical assistance to: (i) strengthen regulatory frameworks, reforms, and public policies that promote gender and racial equality; and (ii) enhance the institutional capacities of federal ministries that work, either directly or transversally, on policies aimed at improving the living conditions of women, the AD population, and traditional communities.
