Specifically, the TC aims to (i) evaluate the relevance, quality, and timeliness of the available information; (ii) identify gaps and limitations in the existing technical, social, environmental, financial, legal, and institutional analyses; and (iii) propose a comprehensive Action Plan to guide the continuation and advancement of the PPP structuring process.
