The objective of this Technical Cooperation is to enhance the integration of climate considerations across Brazil's project portfolio, with a particular focus on mainstreaming adaptation and strengthening adaptation finance mechanisms. The operation will develop sector-specific methodologies, tools, and indicators tailored to the Brazilian context, enabling the systematic incorporation and measurement of climate risks and resilience outcomes in project design and implementation. By building institutional capacity and improving adaptation finance tracking and mobilization, the TC will expand climate finance for adaptation and reinforce the integration of adaptation across IDB operations in Brazil.
