The TFFP was created to: promote development and economic growth in the region through the expansion of trade financing to LAC banks; broaden the sources of trade finance available for LAC importing and exporting companies and support their internationalization; support global and intraregional integration through trade; ensure liquidity in periods of market volatility (program's counter-cyclical role).
