This will be achieved by: Strengthening subnational teams: (i) Building capacity within regional and local government teams; (ii) Improving territorial planning and management: Enhancing the use of planning tools and processes at the subnational level; and (iii) Improving local decentralized infrastructure management: Supporting more effective management of infrastructure projects at the local level.
