Project Description

According to the IADB, the general objective of this Technical Cooperation (TC) is to support the pension system reform process in Chile, in accordance with the guidelines established by Law 21.735. The specific objectives are: (i) to support the development and operational and technological transformation process resulting from the implementation of the reform, with an emphasis on the main changes that the Social Security Institute (IPS) and the Superintendence of Pensions (SP) will need to undertake; and (ii) to support the design and implementation of a public communication and pension education strategy aimed at informing citizens about the changes introduced by the reform, their benefits, and rights, with a special focus on women.
