The aims of this technical cooperation is to support the Attorney General's Office (PGN) in strengthening to preventive, judicial intervention and disciplinary functions. To achieve these objectives, the TC seeks to establish mechanisms to: (i) support the PGN re-engineering to strengthen the approach of citizen participation; (ii) support the decentralization of the PGN through articulation with defense office, legal capacity and regional Public Oversight Committees; and (iii) coordinate the PGN's work with other central level organizations.

The Independent Consultation and Investigation Mechanism (MICI) is the independent complaint mechanism and fact-finding body for people who have been or are likely to be adversely affected by an Inter-American Development Bank (IDB) or Inter-American Investment Corporation (IIC)-funded project. If you submit a complaint to MICI, they may assist you in addressing the problems you raised through a dispute-resolution process with those implementing the project and/or through an investigation to assess whether the IDB or IIC is following its own policies for preventing or mitigating harm to people or the environment.
