Project Description

Esta CT tiene como objetivo crear herramientas e insumos tecnicos que permitan a las ciudades capitales avanzar hacia la carbono-neutralidad. La CT contribuira a: (i) la construccion de una linea base de emisiones de GEI, a traves de los Inventarios Locales de Gases de Efecto Invernadero GEI en concordancia con las directrices del IPCC (Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change, por sus siglas en ingles) y escenarios tendenciales de emisiones en el largo plazo; (ii) la creacion de espacios de formacion y fortalecimiento de las capacidades tecnicas de los gobiernos locales de las ciudades capitales, para crear planes de descarbonizacion y disenar de proyectos alineados con la carbono neutralidad de las ciudades; y (iii) brindar informacion tecnica relevante para las ciudades capitales.
