As specific objectives, it seeks to: (i) ensure the proper final disposal of Solis Waste and mitigate the negative environmental and social impacts of landfills and open-air dumps located in the areas targeted by the intervention; (ii) increase the recovery and valorization of Solid Waste promoting the social inclusion of informal recyclers, gender equity and the participation of women and; (iii) reduce the generation of GHG emissions in the management of Solid Waste.
