This will be achieved through: (i) an analysis of the main challenges facing the country in terms of productive diversification, with particular emphasis on the regulatory and institutional framework, as well as policy instruments; and (ii) an in-depth analysis of two strategic sectors selected based on criteria of economic dynamism, technological development and/or sustainability.
