Project Description

According to the IADB, this Technical Cooperation (TC) is intended to provide support to the Government of Ecuador in the design of its first project (EC-L1318) under the IDB CLIMA Pilot Program. The IDB CLIMA Pilot Program aims to incentivize sector-driven investments that will support the country's agenda of innovation within green thematic markets, green and climate financing, and MRV capacities. To attain this goal, IDB CLIMA offers a grant to borrowers that successfully reach results through sectoral investments measured through Key Performance Indicators (KPI) that: (i) reduce development gaps while delivering impact in terms of nature and climate; (ii) strengthen the sector's capabilities to develop sectoral project pipelines that include climate and/or nature considerations; and (iii) strengthen sector-driven nature and climate monitoring, reporting and verification systems to meet international climate and thematic green debt standards.
