The specific objectives are: (i) to support the design, evaluation, and updating of policies, instruments, and strategies aimed at attracting private investment, facilitating foreign trade, and strengthening businesses; and (ii) to strengthen the technical and institutional capacities of the MPCEI to lead, coordinate, implement, monitor, and evaluate this programmatic agenda.a.
