Project Description

According to the IADB, the objective is to provide technical and operational support to the Executive Hydroelectric Commission of the Rio Lempa (CEL) to facilitate the effective implementation of the Universal Energy Access Program in El Salvador (PAUE), ensuring compliance with the milestones established in the implementation schedule and the proper application of the Bank's technical, fiduciary, and operational standards. The specific objectives are to: (i) develop enabling technical and operational inputs required for the implementation of the PAUE, including designs, technical specifications, and/or monitoring tools; and (ii) strengthen CEL's and Cuscatlan Electric Distribution Company's (DEC) institutional and operational capacities for the management, supervision, and monitoring of energy access programs.
