## **Project Description**

The general objective of the program will be to increase agricultural productivity, agricultural income, and food security for small farmers in selected areas of the North, Artibonite, Grand Anse and South Departments. The program will be structured in two components - Component 1: Applied research and training for the development and adaptation of sustainable agricultural technologies, and Component 2: Promotion of sustainable agricultural technologies.

The program will partially or totally subsidize farmers' access to agricultural inputs, equipment and services linked to these technologies, to be delivered by a network of local suppliers (agro-dealers, cooperatives, individuals, among others).

## Investment Description

The project has an estimated total cost of US\$55 million. The proposed investment is a US\$40 million grant from the IDB Grant Facility.
