The specific objectives are: (i) development of decentralized electrical minigrids with private sector participation; (ii) foster the supply of electricity with RenewableEnergy (RE) in the Parc Industriel de Caracol (PIC); and (iii) strengthening sector regulatory and planning capabilities.
