Project Description

By reinforcing the team and the means of efficiently managing the multiple and cross-cutting interventions that compose the 4 operations in place, the TC will enable the IDB staff on the ground to deliver high quality results, while ensuring compliance with the Bank's standards and regulations, as well as contributing to the strengthening of the Ministry of National Education and Professional Training's Executing Unity (MENFP-UCP), as a result of an agile and outcome-driven supervision.
