Project Description

The proposed project will deepen the portfolio Soppexca Nicaragua in rural areas where it currently operates through the use of individual financing targeted to low-income individual financing needs of about USD 300 to USD 500 on average for working capital and fixed assets.

The IADB has financed a Small Project loan of USD 0.39 million. The government of Nicaragua is providing country counterpart financing of USD 168,000.
