## Project Description

According to the IDB, the objective of this Technical Cooperation is to support the planning process of the master network of the Panama metro, updating in the first phase the socioeconomic and mobility database for the Metropolitan Area of Panama (Districts of Capira, Chorrera and Arraijan, in the province of Panama Oeste, and the districts of Panama, San Miguelito and Chepo, in the province of Panama), by carrying out a Mobility Survey that incorporates a new tool into conventional methodologies that uses data on the geographical position of mobile phone users.
