The objective of the operation is to contribute to cushioning the impact that a severe or catastrophic natural disaster could have on the country's finances, through an increase in the availability, stability and efficiency of contingent financing for the attention of emergencies caused For this type of event. Additionally, the operation seeks to improve the country's comprehensive disaster risk management by promoting improvements in the five strategic axes included in the PGIRDN: (i) governance and development of the governing framework; (ii) identification and knowledge of the risk; (iii) risk reduction; (iv) disaster management; and (v) financial risk management.
