## Project Description

The purpose of the Technical Cooperation is to provide humanitarian aid to those affected by the floods. The resources of the TC will support the activities of the government to address the most urgent needs. The assistance will be in three areas: (i) the provision of a service for the cleaning and sewage discharge of 500 SEN chemical baths; (ii) sensitisation of the population of temporary shelters in water, hygiene and sanitation and protection; and (iii) the installation of mobile classrooms for 170 girls and boys.
