Project Description

According to the IADB, the overall objective of this Technical Cooperation (TC) is to support ANDE in the preparation and execution of clean energy investment operations. The specific objectives are: (i) to improve project management by strengthening the technical, fiduciary, financial, environmental, and social capacities of ANDE staff; (ii) to support the development of technical and regulatory studies that optimize national electricity system planning; and (iii) to promote knowledge and experience exchange through participation in strategic events related to digitalization, innovation, inclusion, gender, and job creation in the energy sector.

As stated on [its website](#) (translated with DeepL.com), ANDE is an autarchic institution, decentralized from the Public Administration, of unlimited duration, with legal status and its own assets. It will be subject to the common civil and commercial provisions, in everything that is not in opposition to the rules contained in Law No. 966 and its subsequent extension.

Its main purpose is to satisfy in an adequate manner the electric energy needs of the country, in order to promote its economic development and foster the welfare of the population, through the preferential use of the natural resources of the Nation.
