According to the Bank's website, the general objective of this IGR is to advance the sustainable management of hazardous C&W; in the Caribbean. Its specific objectives are: i) to strengthen the policy, regulatory and legal enabling environment; ii) to build institutional capacity at the public sector level to properly manage hazardous C&W; iii) to improve the bankability of hazardous C&W; projects to unlock public sector financing for projects targeting hazardous C&W; and iii) to advance knowledge management around C&W; in the Caribbean. This operation will contribute to the implementation of Components 1, 2 and 5 of the Facility.
