### Project Description

The program objective is to contribute to reducing disparities in integration among the countries of the River Plate Basin, focusing on priority border zones, through the implementation of FONPLATA-financed projects



### Investment Description

- Inter-American Development Bank (IADB)

The CCLIP will be up to US \$ 300 million, will be 12 years long, and will consist of three individual global credit investment loan operations. The first will be a US \$ 100 million loan and a 4 years tenure period. The subsequent ones for amounts of approximately US \$ 100 million and durations of around 4 years. The first individual operation will be financed by a Global Credit Investment Loan denominated in United States dollars with a charge to Ordinary Capital (CO) resources.

### Financial Intermediary

Financial Intermediary: A commercial bank or financial institution that receives funds from a development bank. A financial intermediary then lends these funds to their clients (private actors) in the form of loans, bonds, guarantees and equity shares. Financial intermediaries include insurance, pension and equity funds. The direct financial relationship is between the development bank and the financial intermediary.
